Since 1948, Israel has demolished well over 100,000 Palestinian homes – at least 50,000 in 1948 and the years immediately following, untold thousands more within Israel since that time and some 48,000 in the Occupied Territory from 1967 until today. These are not only individual homes, but entire villages, towns, urban neighbourhoods and cities have been uprooted and destroyed – the very fabric of Palestinian society. And the process of ethnic cleansing of which home demolitions is a part, a process and policy Israel officially calls the "judaization" of Palestine, continues today on both sides of the "Green Line."
